In Our Store

We have a few new items in the store this month:

- Nut & Fruit Blend Bird Feed (Has a blend of raisins, peanuts, almonds, pecans, walnuts, and dried cherries.) **\$10.25/7LB Bag**
- Wells Lamont White Mule Gloves (Size L and XL) **\$9.75/Pair**
- PT Alpine Pressured Fly Bait **\$25.00/16oz Can**

In the Yard

- How is your yard looking? If it is a little yellow, consider adding granular or liquid iron this time of year. Products we carry: **Dr. Iron Granules= \$19.95/7LB Jug, Dr. Iron Granules= \$18.50/7LB Bag or Ironite Granules = \$17.50/15LB Bag, Ironite Liquid = \$10.95/32 Oz hose end sprayer**
- Is your yard healthy enough to make the final summer push? Consider adding an additional application of fertilizer to keep it looking the best. Products we carry: **EZ Gro 19-5-9 Fertilizer = \$18.25/40LB Bag or 21-7-14 Fertilizer = \$16.50/50LB Bag**
- If your yard needs beneficial microbes to activate the tired soil, try Medina Plus or Medina Soil Activator. It is formulated to be "Yogurt for the Soil." We have it in quarts and gallons. **Medina Plus \$15.95/GAL or \$5.45/QT or Medina Soil Activator \$10.75/GAL**

In the Pasture

Are the mesquites and brush looking healthy at your place? Consider getting rid of them with the products below:

- Sendero = Designed as "The New Standard in Mesquite Control." This product works best as individual plant treatment as a foliar spray on 4FT or smaller plants. Another benefit of this product is that it is a non-restricted product. **Dow's recommendation on a 25 gallon mix is 32oz Sendero, 8oz surfactant, 8-16oz blue dye, and the remainder water.** You should be using this product when the leaves are dark green and the plant is not stressed. Avoid spraying this product in times of drought. Apply the mixture to where the leaves are wet, but not to the point of runoff. It is better to spray in the early morning when the humidity is higher and temperatures are moderate.
- Pastureguard in Quarts = Designed to get the hard to control brush on fence lines. This product is best if applied on each side of the fence line. This is also a non-restricted product. **Dow's recommendation on a 25 gallon mix is 1qt Pastureguard, 8oz surfactant, 8-16oz blue dye, and the remainder water.** Apply the mixture to where the leaves are wet, but not to the point of runoff. It is better to spray in the early morning when the humidity is higher and temperatures are moderate. We also carry this product in 2.5 gallons.
- We received a new shipment of 12V sprayers in 25 gallons and 15 gallons. We have ones rated for diesel and other chemicals.
- We received a new shipment of Gun Jet Spray Guns. These are ideal if you are spot spraying brush.

In the Animal Pen

We are working to get more pet products in the store. For all you chicken lovers, take a look at the product below:

- Kaytee Mealworms = These are a great high protein source for many wild birds. **We carry a 7oz bag for \$6.75 each.**

In the Great Outdoors
