## In Our Store

- We have started selling PVC joints in shorter lengths than the full joint. We are now selling the ½”, ¾”, and 1” in 5FT and 10FT joints. We will not be able to sell any shorter lengths than these. We will still sell them by the full joints.
- We have made some changes to the way we are loading customer orders. In the past, customers could tell the gentlemen in the back what they wanted and have it loaded when you went back outside. This has created issues with our inventory, especially when we are out of something or a customer’s choice changes. Going forward, we will load **after** the yellow ticket is received. I appreciate everyone’s patience on these changes as this is one of the many changes we are making to serve you better.

## In the Yard

- It is the time of year that you may need to watch for brown patches in your yard. Symptoms first appear as small circular patches of water-soaked, dark grass that soon wilts and turns a light brown color. As the disease develops, the circular patches enlarge and become more apparent, and new green leaves may emerge in the center of the circular areas. The severity of the disease can be controlled to some extent by avoiding heavy applications of nitrogen during spring and fall, by watering early in the morning to remove dew and allow the grass to dry quickly, and where possible, remove grass clippings during periods of disease activity. A curative control to halt the disease is **Consan**. This product was highlighted in the August newsletter.
- This is another good time to apply **Medina Soil Activator** or **Medina Plus**. This will allow your yard to receive the nutrients it needs to keep the diseases at bay and keep the soil rich for the yard’s health.

## In the Pasture

For those of you who are getting the ground ready for fall grasses and wildlife food plots, we are having a Meet and Greet with Dr. Bade and Jeff Pauler from Central Garden. **This event will take place on Friday September 15, 2017 at the store.** At the Meet and Greet, they will address any questions on fall grasses and food plots.

- We have ordered some oats, ryegrass, and wildlife food plot seed for fall planting. If you are interested in purchasing some seed, please let us know in advance so we can have it for you. Best time to plant these seeds is in the late part of September, if the conditions are correct.
- At the end of this month, we should be in the fall spraying window for huisache. If you are interested in spraying, please give us a call.

## In the Animal Pen

- We have adjusted prices on more feed in the store. **Purina Ranch Hand Beef Builder \$8.50/50LB Bag, Purina 3/8 Creep \$8.15/50LB Bag.** Prices on liquid feed has also dropped to **\$.15/LB for the Protein and \$.17/LB on Protein with the Fly Control.**
- We have been informed by our suppliers that it will be difficult to get the Ivomec Injectable wormers in the future. The ones we have in stock will expire in 2019. We have put them on sale for the prices below. They are being replaced by **Noromectin Plus**.

### **Ivomec Injectable**

- We are now carrying **Fusoguard** for hoof rot. This product helps reduce foot rot and liver abscesses due to *Fusobacterium necrophorum*. (Labeled for use in healthy cattle 6 months of age or older.) **\$14.95/20ML**
- **Outlast Gastric Support** – We have started carrying this product for those who expect the most from their horses. This product is formulated to support gastric health and proper PH.
- **Precon with Bovatec** – We have started carrying this product. This is a medicated product that does not require a license. In speaking with our Purina Sales Rep, this would be a good alternative to those who do not have the prescription, but need the Coccidiosis protection. Signs of Coccidiosis are diarrhea, rough coat, loss of appetite, and weight loss.
- We have some older feed in the store that we need to get rid of. Come check out the feeds we are selling at a discount to see if they may fit your needs.

### **In the Great Outdoors**

- We have **DOX Deer Blinds** for sale. This is the same one as you enter the warehouse out of the double doors. We only have 4 available and do not plan to order anymore unless the demand is there. Price for these deer blinds is **\$690.00 Each**.
