In Our Store

We have some events and specials going on this month:

- **On the week of September 21-26, we have a sale promotion going on for Eprinex Pour on Wormer in various sizes from 5L-10L.** You will receive the rebate only when you purchase this week, and there is no limit to the amount you can purchase. The only recommendation is that you please let us know how much you would like in advance so we can have it available. Examples of the cost savings is **\$32.00 off 5L (Current Price \$357.15/Each), \$75.00 off 10L (Current Price \$697.84).**
- **I mentioned over the last few months that we are on a cube contract with Purina until the end of September. We would like to use up the remainder of this contract. To increase the sales, we are going to reduce the price on DeWitt Cubes to \$9.05/50LB Bag and Purina Cubes to \$8.36/50LB Bag. This pricing will be valid until the contract ends or we use up the quantity.**
- **We noticed toward the end of our Pallet of Corn Day that some of the pallets did not have cardboard on the bottom. This caused a puncture in some of the bottom bags. If you had some busted bags, please let us know, and we will replace them. Sorry for the mess and inconvenience.**

In the Yard

- It is the time of the year where our yards will make the tough transition from the heat of the summer to the cooler fall. We have preventative options available to help keep them looking good. If you see brown patch starting in your yard or consistently have an issue with an area in your yard, consider an application of **Bayer Fungicide in a liquid hose-end spray \$20.00/32oz RTU or granular formula \$17.75/10LB Bag.**
- The fall months can also bring along the presence of **Sod Webworms**. The best indication of their presence is small white moths flying around your yard. The best treatment is an application of insecticide 3 times in the course of 2 weeks. **Products available for the application are Bifen IT \$36.45/QT Concentrate and Cyonara \$13.10/QT Concentrate. The best recommendation is to alternate the chemical used in the application.**

In the Pasture

- In the fall of each year, we have an opportunity to improve our pasture and hay field soil health. When many of you receive back a soil sample it recommends an application of lime and high amounts of phosphorus and potash. Now is the time to plan for these applications. These additions take time to work and should be done prior to the spring of next year. **Cost for the Ag Lime is \$42.50/TON plus application.** Please call the store for current pricing on the phosphorus and potash.
- **We are in the prime time for an application to control Huisache.** The recommendation is to make the application to a healthy plant by spot spraying them or a broadcast application. We always ask that our customers make sure to remember a couple best practices after the application: **1) Do not shred or cut down the plants for 6 months -1 year after the application. 2) Once you get a head start on the brush control, continue with an annual chemical application for brush or an annual weed spray plan to keep them under control. Make sure to use a good surfactant when making the application. We use the product called Airforce when making our broadcast applications. Usage rate on the Airforce is 4 oz/Acre or .2 oz/ Gallon of water.** I am sure everyone has a story of a place they sprayed once, had a good kill, and it quickly took over after only a few years of neglect. If you need help with getting a plan together or would like us to come look at your place, please let us know.
- We will have most fall seeds in stock by the start of the second week of September. We have finalized the pricing below and options available below:

- **TAM 411 Oats** = \$20.00/50LB Bag

- **Nelson Ryegrass** = \$30.70/50LB Bag

- **Spicer Ryegrass** = \$30.70/50LB Bag

- **Purple Top Turnip** = \$1.60/LB

- **Pasarrel Ryegrass** = \$30.70/50LB Bag

- **Gulf Ryegrass** = \$23.45/50LB Bag

- There will be a minor hiccup in the fertilizer available for fall seed blends. Through some federal legal issues, DAP (18-46-0) will be hard to acquire. This ingredient is used to make majority of the blends in our dry fertilizer plant. We have reformulated some of the more popular blends to use another product called Triple Super Phosphate (0-46-0). You should see no difference in the performance of the fertilizer. We will only have select blends available for use. You can call or stop by the store to see what blends we have available.
- If you would like to apply your own seeds, we have some **three point cone seeders** available for purchase. **Cost is \$805.00/Each.**

In the Animal Pen

- We have taken some time to look at our pricing on some more popular items. **We have adjusted the pricing on the Alfalfa Hay Cubes to \$12.05/50LB Bag.** Unless pricing from our supplier changes, this will be the new price going forward.
- For all our stock show customers, we have a deal this month only. **We are offering all Purina Hi Octane Show Supplements at a 5% discount.** This will apply on products like Champion Drive, Ultra Full, Depth Charge, Power Fuel, Paylean, and many others. **Our plan is to take orders leading up to September 19, 2020 and delivery on September 25, 2020. The discount will only apply to this order, and you will need to take delivery of all the product ordered at one time. If you are interested, please order by September 19, 2020. If you have any questions, please let us know.**

In the Great Outdoors

- There is always an interest in trying something new when it comes to attracting deer and other wildlife. We have started carrying two new feeds that may excite your wildlife. **Feeder Max Candy Corn \$13.75/50LB Bag is a mixture of sunflowers, corn, and peanuts with an apple scent. Hunters Edge Takeout \$14.70/50LB Bag is a mixture of Corn and Roasted Soybeans with a Persimmon flavor.** Both of these products will feed though your deer feeders.
- We have a special on **Antlermax Blocks \$13.45/Each and Quick Draw Blocks \$10.74/Each** this month. This pricing reflects \$1.00 off the current price. Stop in the store to try something new around your feeders.
- To hold those new blocks, we have some **All Seasons EZ Block Feeders** to keep them high and dry off the ground from those animals you do not want to eat the block. They can be mounted on a post or tree. Cost for the block holder is **\$50.70/Each.**
- We have our fall wildlife food plot seeds available:
 - Rackmaster Supreme Fall Mix** (Combination of annual grasses, clovers, winter peas, and brassicas for an all-around fall mix) **\$34.50/50LB Bag**
 - Durana Clover** (Great for deer, turkeys, and other wildlife) **\$3.75/LB**
 - Deer Greens** (Combination of rape, purple top turnip, kale, and trophy radish) **\$19.20/5LB Bag**
 - Pogue Seed Buck Buffet** (Combination of wheat, oats, triticale, and winter peas) **\$44.50/65LB Bag**
 - We can also get winter peas and other seeds by themselves. Simply ask if you are interested.**
- **We will have a Fish Day from Henneke Fish Farm on Friday, September 25th 10:30-12:00. If you are interested, we have order forms in the store and a list of the fish available. Orders need to be placed prior to September 24th @12:00.**
